Dear Mr. Joy,

This letter is a follow up to activities and access regarding Longview Timberlands on Rocky Point Rd., Scappoose, OR. Because of your efforts to rectify the problems in this area by restoring the forest back to a natural state and removing the man made jumps and trails, Longview Timberlands LLC will allow members of PUMP and the mountain biking community to have access for trail riding on Longview Timberlands.

As we discussed, the damaging, altering, or destroying of the natural surroundings, plant life, and or trees are totally unacceptable. As long as we agree that no further man made excavation, jumps, and/or trails will be constructed by anyone in your group, this area will remain open for non-motorized biking. No one person or group has been authorized in any manner, to change any ground on Longview Timberlands as you know.

Because you are the most prevalent group of persons utilizing this area as stated by your riders and the many postings on your website, please pass on and have your members follow the listed rules:

1. DO NOT destroy any plant life, cut or damage any tree, or excavate any land.
2. DO NOT construct any other trails.
3. NO commercial activities of any kind in front of or behind Longview Timber gates or on Longview Timberland in any manner.
4. Non-motorized biking only is allowed on Longview Timberlands.
5. Day use only.



6. Prohibited Activities Include:

- a. Removal of any forest products without permits
- b. Fires and camping
- c. Transporting or Dumping of Garbage
- d. Target Shooting
- e. Unauthorized motor vehicles
- f. Off road vehicles (motorized) of any kind
- g. Blocking of any gates / vehicles will be towed immediately and without warning

In addition to the above, please be aware of the following:


- Gates may be open and closed (locked) at any time without warning.
- Forest lands may be closed for high fire danger.
- When forest operations occur, all public entry will be prohibited.
- Privilege of entry may be revoked at any time.

I appreciate your willingness and continued efforts to help and make sure that these above rules are followed and that if any violation of these rules is observed that it could be reported to Longview Timberlands LLC right away.

As I stated in my previous letter, I know that you have limited areas to do this type of riding but as we discussed, this area is private timber land and a working forest area. Longview Timber has a long and proud history of letting our neighbors recreate on our lands and wishes to continue this as much as possible.

Again thank you and please pass on thanks to your members for their efforts in restoring the forest lands. I know that we can make this a great relationship for a long period of time if we both do our part to work together.
