Project: Wilson River Trail Restoration

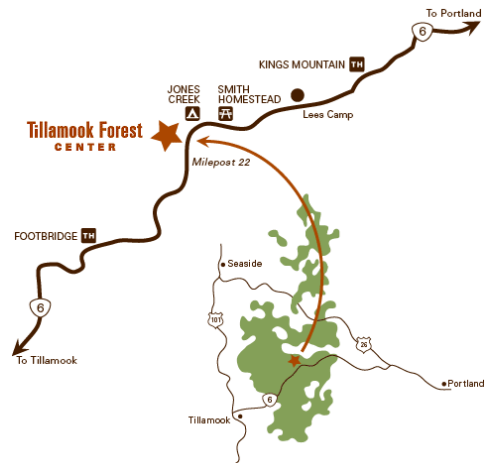
Project Date: March 20th, May 15th, July 17th, September 11th

Meeting Time: Sign-In at 9:30 A.M. / Trail Construction Starts at 10:00 A.M.

Meeting Location: Tillamook Forest Center Parking Lot (West End)

Driving Directions from Portland:

- Highway 26 westbound toward the Oregon Coast
- Take exit 53 onto Highway 6 (*marked Highway 6 / Tillamook / Ocean Beaches*)
- Highway 6 westbound to milepost 22.5
- The Tillamook Forest Center is just west of the turn-off to Jones Creek Campground



Project Description:

This is a new trail construction project. Work will include clearing vegetation, excavation, and grading. This trail is being built to a moderate standard for hiker, horse, and mountain bike use. It is being constructed to the following specifications:

Trail Width:	30 inches - Full Bench
Clearing Width:	6 feet at pack height (3 feet each side of centerline)
Clearing Height:	10 feet

The project will require walking and working on steep uneven terrain and hiking off trail and on trail already built in order to access the work site.

Tools provided by ODF but you are welcome to bring your own tools if you prefer.

Appropriate clothing for the work includes boots or sturdy shoes, long pants (no shorts), and gloves. Volunteers should also bring lunch and water. ***Please no dogs or children under age 12.***

Contact Nathan Seable at least a week before volunteer workday so an adequate number of tools are reserved. Last minute workers are welcome too.

Project: SOLV Day Cleanup

Project Date: April 17th, 2010

Meeting Time: Registration begins at 8:15 A.M. / Clean-up from 9:00 – 1:00

Meeting Location: Summit of Highway 6 at the ODOT Sand shed (Milepost 33).

Project Location: The cleanup sites are located in the Browns Camp, Rogers Camp, Drift Creek, Reehers Camp area, and along the Wilson River Highway corridor.

Project Description:

Clean up of tire dumps, clean up of garbage at dispersed camping areas, illegal dumpsites, and areas along forest roads and trails, and removal of abandoned vehicles. Work may require walking and working on steep terrain. *ODF group leaders will be provided to guide volunteers to clean-up areas.*

Appropriate clothing for the work includes boots or sturdy shoes, long pants, and gloves. It usually rains for this event so prepare for wet weather. Volunteers should also bring lunch and water.

There is always a lot of debris to haul, if you have them, please bring vehicles or trailers that can be used to haul bagged garbage, tires, and scrap metal.

Snacks will be provided.

If you plan to participate, please contact Stephanie Beall, at the Forest Grove District office, at least one week prior to the work party date.

Please do not bring dogs or kids under age 12.

Project: Step Creek Trail

Project Date: June 19th, August 21st, October 16th

Meeting Time: Sign-In at 9:30 A.M. / Trail Construction Starts at 10:00 A.M.

Meeting Location: Reehers Camp Day Use Trailhead

Driving Directions from Portland:

- Highway 26 westbound toward the Oregon Coast
- At milepost 38 turn left onto Timber Road
- Follow Timber Road to the town of Timber.
- Turn west onto Cochran Road and travel 2.5 miles to the trailhead located just past the campground.

Project Description:

This is a new trail construction project. Work will include clearing vegetation, excavation, and grading. This trail is being built to a moderate standard for hiker, horse, and mountain bike use. It is being constructed to the following specifications.

Trail width	30 inches - Full Bench
Clearing width	6 feet at pack height (3 feet each side of centerline)
Clearing height	10 feet

The project will require walking and working on steep uneven terrain and hiking off trail and on trail already built in order to access the work site.

The Oregon Department of Forestry will provide the tools, but anything you can bring will be appreciated.
